the said Commissioners with regard to Lord Fairfax and his Grant, and at the same time if opportunely decyde you, you may communicate to Lord Fairfax that I am very desirous of settling proper Limits conclusive between him and me in regard to my Province of Maryland and his Grant in Virginia; and in the mean time you must make and have a good look out, and warning given to such Persons as shall venture to settle on such disputed Boundaries between my Province of Maryland and the Province of Virginia under the said Grant to Lord Fairfax.

72) You are to acquaint and make known to the Council of State, It having been Represented and transmitted to me the account and Circumstances of a Barbarous Murder committed by Jacob Kitzmiller on the Body of Mr. Sudley Digges at a Place survey'd under a Maryland Warrant within our Jurisdiction of Maryland, before the date of His Majesty's most gracious order in Council dated at Kensington the 25th of May 1730, and you are to consult and Advise with the said Council of State, into the Nature Circumstance and validity of this heinous Crime committed by the said Jacob Kitzmiller, not only in regard to the Perpetration thereof, but the Locality of my Jurisdiction of the Place wherein it was committed; and in case you shall find that the said Murder was so committed within the Jurisdiction of our said Province, you are to take all the means possible either by Proclamation or otherwise as the Law prescribes, for the apprehending taking and bringing the said Offender to Justice, according to the known Laws in that Case made and provided.
