Whereas His Majesty's order in Council of the 19<sup>th</sup> of April 1752. was sent to Samuel Ogle Esq<sup>r</sup> late Lieutenant Governor of our Province of Maryland, about transmitting to the Board of Trade an authentic Copy of all the Laws of our said Province: And Whereas our Attorney General by our Council of our said Province, is directed to transmit the said Laws in pursuance of His Majesty's said order. You are to take care that such Transmissions be only conformable to His Majesty's order, which is, to send over an authentic Copy of all Laws now in force within our said Province.

Whereas great controversy is in dispute between the Proprietors of Pennsylvania and my self as Proprietor of Maryland, concerning the several Boundaries of the Two Provinces, and yet undetermined; I therefore do require of you with the advice of our Council of state, to act consistent in Maintenance of My Rights, Juridictions and Property, in the most amicable manner as is possible; and at the same time in the Protection and support of my present or future Tenants holding within my Jurisdiction of our said Province, and conformable to His Majesty's order in Council dated at Kensington the 25<sup>th</sup> day of May. 1750.
