

as usual Five p Cent on the net money paid into the
hands of My Agent and Receiver General. Their offices are
to state the Annual Quit Rents arising from and payable
by My Tenants in each County within our said Province;
from the Accounts thereof heretofore and from time to time
transmitted to them the said Rent Roll Keepers from our
Land Office, and from our Commissary General as to Lands De-
vised; and to make out and sign separate Rent Rolls, annually
to be a charge on the several Receivers or Farmers of our
said Revenues to collect by, and for those Farmed to become
answerable to me for the same. AND whereas by our
Instruction from My Beloved Guardians during my minority
the late Lieutenant Governor Ogle was required to be Assent
to the Agent and Receiver General in the ordering perfect Rent
Rolls of my Revenues to be made out and authenticated
and sent over to England for inspection and examining thereby
the Agent and Receiver Generals future accounts. If such
are not yet finished, you are to assist My Agent and Receiver
General in the calling upon the Rent Roll Keepers to hasten
the perfecting the same; which are to be authenticated
by our Judge of the Land Office having examined and finding
them to be true from the several Rents reserved by the Grants
taken out from that office.

78. You, with our Judge of the Land Office, and Se-
cretary in our said Province for the time being, are to ad-
vise My Agent and Receiver General (who is instructed to
consult You thereupon) to farm for My Use Benefit and Service,
all my Quit Rents which have been heretofore usually Farmed;
and to appoint Receivers of those he cannot Farm throughout our
said Province of Maryland and Dominion thereunto belonging;
at a lower rate if possible than the extraordinary allowance of
Twenty
