Instructions to the late Lieutenant Governor Ogle, the
Income arising from this Act was directed to be applied
to maintain a proper Force on the Borders of both shores
which has been generally considered here as of dangerous
Consequence, and highly improper to be continued —
You are therefore hereby required and directed to re-
call and supercede such Directions, and to putt a Stopp
to and prevent any such future Application thereof —
And to give the necessary and proper Orders and Directions
to my Agent and Receiver General within our said
Province to render to me an exact account of the produce
arising from the said Act, as well as of the Fines thereby
imposed. — The same to be collected Paid and Placed
to my account for my Benefit and use, and this I
recommend to your Particular care and notices.

54) **AS** Application may be made for Parcels
or Quantities of Lands on our Borders and Frontiers of
our said Province westward and North west near and
about the Fountain Head of Potomack River, in
order to the Settlement of British Subjects, Protestant
Germans or Palatines there on, to promote and carry
on an Indian Trade and other Improvements. And
as I am willing to give all due Encouragement to pro-
mote Settlements on the remote Parts of our said
Province of Maryland, I hereby Direct and order you
with the Advice of our Judge of our Land Office and
Agent and Receiver General a fore said, That warrants
be issued out for such Quantity of Lands to such Persons
who
