who shall apply for the same, where they shall think fit
on the remote Borders and Parts of our said Province as
afore-said; and that upon their giving good Security for
the caution money the Term of Years shall be allowed
for the payment thereof, and the Quittances for the
same shall be fixed, in such manner and on such conditions
as the Presente Penns Proprietors of Pennsylvania have
settled and fixed on the Borders and Frontiers of their
said Province of Pennsylvania, of which you must inform
your self in the best manner you can; and to be paid
me in such manner as is most advisable from such
Settlers and Inhabitants on the remotest parts and Borders
of our said Province as afore-said; And my further will
is, that there shall be a Proviso in each of the said Grants
of such Lands, that if they shall not be settled by such
a certain number of Families or Inhabitants which you
are to direct to be ascertained in the said Grants within
years from the dates of the said grants, that then such
Grants shall be void. And you are not to ascertain more
than Five hundred acres in any one such grant.

85.) You shall direct the Surveyor of the several
counties to take Certificates out of our Land office
of the manors in their respective Counties and to make
fair Draughts and Plans of the said manors, and re-
turn one Copy thereof to my Agent, another you shall
transmit to me or our Secretary residing in England to
be laid before me, and a third they shall keep by them;
you shall take care to direct that the surveys be com-
pleted within twelve months, or two Years.
