You with the advice of our Judge of the Land Office, our
Secretary in the Province, and my Agent and Receiver
General aforesaid, to have now Survey's made of Particular
Parcels of Land in and about our said Province to be judicial-
ly reserved in our several Counties &c. and erected
into Manors to hold Court Baron and to have view of
Frank-Pledge for me and my Heirs.

88.) And you are to give Directions to our Judge
of our Land office, that for the future he is not to make
out any Grant of Land or Lands in any of our Counties
that are well inhabited to any one Person or Family ex-
ceeding the Number of one Thousand Acres, and the said number
of acres is to be made out in two distinct Grants not exceeding
Five hundred Acres each, in which I hope where the situation
and Goodness of the Lands are valuable I shall have some
Regard shown me of a more valuable Improved Quit Rents
with the Reservations; This Improvement of Property is now
highly necessary for me to have considered, as I am inform'd
that most of my Property in the several well inhabited parts
of our Counties consisting of immense Tracts are already
granted out in Fee under small reserved Quit Rents, which
lands whilst uncultivated have been by the Professors sold
off to numbers of inhabitants which yearly flow in and settle
in our said Province, at a price and under such reserved Rents
as bears no proportion in value to the Quit Rents reserved
and made payable by the original Grantees, to the great prejudice
of me and my Heirs. Therefore I desire your Consideration on these
Points and your Remarks thereon from time to time, and that You
will be watchful and render me Beneficial Service in this Point of my
Property; and that You will take care that these inconveniences be
well and effectually guarded against in all Future
Grants.
