The Suit of our Peace and whatsoever appertaineth unto us
for that he on the twenty first day of October in the year
of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and eighty five be-
tween the hours of ten and twelve in the night of the
same day with force and Arms at the County of Baltimore
the Store house of a certain Peter Walter then there situ-
ate feloniously and burglariously did break and enter
and too pieces of Orderoy of the value of five pounds current
Money of Maryland each piece of the Goods and Chattels of
the said Peter Walter then there in the said Store house being
found there and there feloniously and burglariously did steal
take and carry away against the Peace Government and
Dignity of Maryland and so forth and contrary to the Act
of Assembly in that case made and provided, whereof he
the said Joseph Burgess hath been convicted before the
Worshipful Andrew Buchanan and other Justices of the
County Court of the same County hold at the Court house
in Baltimore Town the Tuesday before the Monday pre-
ceding the first Tuesday in February in the year of our
Lord One thousand seven hundred and eighty six Never-
theless we grant unto him the said Joseph Burgess our
firm Peace and will not that he suffer any corporal or
other Punishment therefor but that he shall stand and be
in the same Plight and Condition to all Intents and pu-
poses whatsoever as if the Crime whereof he the said Joseph
Burgess hath been convicted had never been done or committed

Lord One thousand, seven hundred and eighty six
