To all our Bailiffs and good
People to whom these Presents
shall come Greeting

Whereas Edmund War-
riner of Baltimore County Yeoman stands indicted in Balti-
more County Court for altering the Sum in a Bond to him-
self from a certain Thomas Graves by altering Eight
pounds to Eighty: and for altering an Order from Samuel
Passon on George Evans & Son to deliver him flour by
which he obtained the delivery of two Barrels of flour
instead of one. & Nevertheless we grant unto him the said
Edmund Warriner our Firm Peace and will not that he
suffer any corporal or other Punishment therefor but that he
shall stand and be in the same Flight and Extradition to
all Intents and Purposes whatsoever as if his Crimes or
Offences aforesaid had never been done or committed -

Provided and it is the express Condition of our Pardon
that the said Edmund Warriner shall depart this State
within Thirty days after the delivery of these Presents
and that he never afterwards returns back into it -

Year of our Lord One thousand Seven Hundred
and eighty six
