To all our Bailiffs and good  
M<sup>r</sup> Smallwood. People to whom these Presents shall  
come Greeting

Know ye that of our  
especial Grace we have Pardoned unto Negro Myah, the Slave  
of Budget Tull late of Baltimore County Spinner, as a  
proper Object of our Mercy the Suit of our Peace and what  
Dower appertaineth unto us for that he on the nineteenth  
Day of April in the year of our Lord seventeen hundred and eighty  
six about the hour of ten in the night of the same Day  
with force and Arm at Baltimore County aforesaid the  
Store house of a certain Andrew Skinner Esq<sup>r</sup> there  
situate feloniously and Burglariously did break and enter  
and four pair of paste knee Buckies of the value of three  
pounds ten shillings current Money, five Portugal half  
Crownes of the value of fifteen pounds current Money  
eighteen English Guineas of the value of twenty eight pounds  
current Money, four half Guineas of the value of three  
pounds current Money, two french Guineas of the value  
of three pounds nine shillings current Money, two Lioles  
and one half Liole of the value of five pounds current  
Money, One Pistole of the value of twenty eight shilling  
current Money and two Moldores of the value of four  
pounds current Money of the Goods and Chattels of  
the said Andrew Skinner Esq<sup>r</sup> in the same Store house  
then and there feloniously and Burglariously did steal  
take and carry away contrary to the form of the law
