 the Peace Government and Dignity of the State of Maryland,
 whereof he the said Negro Myah hath been convicted
 before the worshipful John Hoale and others his Associates
 Justices of Baltimore County Court held at the Court House
 in Baltimore Town in and for the County aforesaid the
 Tuesday before the Monday preceeding the first Tuesday in
 June in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and
 eighty six. Nevertheless we grant unto him the said
 Negro Myah our full Peace and will not that he suffer
 any Corporal or other Punishment therefor but that he
 shall stand and be in the same Plight and Condition to
 all Intents and Purposes whatsoever as if the Crime whereof
 he the said Myah hath been convicted had never been done
 or committed Provided the said Bridget Dull shall
 transport or cause to be transported out of this State the
 said Negro Myah within twenty Days after the delivery
 of these Presents never to return back into it again.
