To all our Baillifs and good People
to whom these Presents shall come Greeting

Whereas a Negro Peter the Pro-

perty of Cyprian Wells of Baltimore County is now confined
in the Gaol of the said County on a Commitment to appear as
an Evidence against a Negro Ben charged with and commit-
ted for Felony, and Whereas there are strong Grounds to
suspect that the said Peter is an Aider and Abetter of the
said Felony, and it has been represented to us that it were
more for the good and Safety of the Community that the said
Negro Peter be removed from the State and pardoned on that
Condition Know ye therefore that we of our especial Grace
have Pardoned and by these Presents do grant unto him the
said Peter our firm Peace and will not that he suffer any
corporal or other Punishment therefore for any Offence or Offences
which he the said Peter may have committed or been in
any wise concerned previous to the date of these Presents
Provided that Cyprian Wells the proprietor of the said Peter
shall transport or cause to be transported out of this State
the said Peter within twenty Days from the date hereof
and never to return back into the same —
