

our Mercy the Suit of our Peace and whatsoever appertaineth unto us for that he on the seventeenth day of June in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and eighty six with force and arms at the County aforesaid the Store house of a certain George Biscoe of the County aforesaid there situated (not being contiguous to or used with any Mansion House) did feloniously break and enter and twenty gallons of Rum of the value of three pounds ten shillings current Money, four gallons of collapses of the value of eight shillings current Money, five Jugs of the value of ten shillings current Money, One Keg of the value of three Shillings current Money One Case with twelve Bottles of the value of twelve shillings current Money, half a Bushel of Salt of the value of two Shillings current money the Goods and Chattels of the said George Biscoe then in the said Store house being then and there feloniously stole took and carried away Contrary to the Act of Assembly in such Case made and provided and against the Peace Government and Dignity of the State, whereof he the said Elijah hath been convicted before the Worshipful Jeremiah Jordan and others Justices of the County Court of the said County held at the Court house in Leonard Town in and for the County aforesaid on the seventh day of September in the Eleventh year of the State and in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and eighty six Nevertheless we grant unto him the said Elijah our full Peace and will not that he suffer any Corporal or other Punishment therefore
