 eighty six with force and arms at the County aforesaid
 the Store house of a certain George Bisce of the County

 with any Mansion house) did feloniously break and en-
 ter and twenty gallons of Rum of the value of three
 pounds ten shillings current Money, four gallons of
 Molasses of the value of eight shillings current Money,
 five Tugs of the value of ten shillings current Money,
 One Keg of the value of three shillings current Money
 One Case with twelve Bottles of the value of twelve
 shillings current Money, half a Bushel of Salt of the
 value of two shillings current money the Goods and
 Chattels of the said George Bisce then in the said Store
 house being then and there ~~unlawfully~~ feloniously stole took
 and carried away contrary to the Act of Assembly in such
 Case made and provided and against the Peace Govern-
 ment and Dignity of the State, whereof he the said Elyah
 hath been convict before the Worshipful Jeremiah
 Jordan and other Justices of the County Court of the
 said County held at the Court house in Leonard Town
 in and for the County aforesaid on the seventh day
 of September in the Eleventh year of the State and in
 the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and
 eighty six Nevertheless we grant unto him the
 said Elyah our firm Peace and will not that he
 suffer any Corporal or other Punishment therefor
