 Richard otherwise called Dick our full Peace and Will
 not that he suffer any Corporal or other Punishment
 therefor but that he shall stand and be in the same
 Flight and Condition to all Intents and Purposes what-
 soever as if the crime whereof he the said Negro
 Richard otherwise called Dick hath been convict had
 never been done or committed Provided the aforesaid
 John Parker shall within Thirty days after the delivery
 hereof, or as soon thereafter as the weather and other
 Circumstances will permit, transport or cause to be
 transported the said Negro Richard otherwise called
 Dick to some one of the West India Islands or
 otherwise beyond the Seas never to return again

Whereas it hath been represented by the
 Memorial of several of the Inhabitants of the County of
 Maryland, that a Dispute respecting the Title of a
 certain Tract of Land lying and being in the said County
 hath subsisted for some time between Patrick McGee
