 County Yeoman, as a proper Object of our Mercy, the Suit
 of our Peace, and whatsoever appertaineth unto us for that
 he on the tenth Day of September in the year of our Lord
 One thousand, seven hundred and eighty six between the
 hours of ten and twelve in the night of the same Day,
 with force and arms at the County of Cecil aforesaid the
 mansion house of a certain Patrick Hamilton then there
 situate, feloniously and burglariously did break and enter,
 and one broad Cloth Coat of the value of twenty shillings
 Current Money, one pair of Cotton velvet breeches of
 the value of twenty shillings like Money, one pair of
 worsted Stockings of the value of five shillings like
 Money, one Silver pint Can of the value of forty
 shillings like Money, one pair of Silver Sugar Tongs
 of the value of fifteen shillings like Money, one Silver
 table spoon of the value of five shillings like Money,
 one Silver tea spoon of the value of two shillings like
 Money, and one pair of calf skin shoes of the value
 of ten shillings Current Money of Maryland of the Goods
 and Chattels of the said Patrick Hamilton then and
 there in the said mansion house being found, then and
 there feloniously and burglariously did steal, take
 and carry away against the Peace, Government, and
 Dignity of Maryland, whereof he the said John Dock-
 herty hath been convicted before the Worshipful Joseph
 Gilpin and others, Justices of the County Court of the same
 County begun and hold in and for Cecil County aforesaid at
 the Court House in Charles Town on the Monday
