found feloniously did steal take and carry away contrary to
the Peace Government and Dignity of the State of Maryland
whereof the said Mary McGuire on an Indictment found
by the Grand Inquest for the Body of Baltimore County at
this present February Term seventeen hundred and eighty seven
on which Indictment the said Mary McGuire was arraigned
at the Bar of the Court aforesaid and confessed that she was
guilty of the matter whereof she stands indicted and thereupon
it was asked by the Court of the said Mary what she had to
say for herself why sentence of Death should not pass upon
her on the Indictment and Confession aforesaid upon which
she prayed the Benefit of the clergy which prayer was granted
and thereupon it was adjudged by the Court that the said Mary
McGuire be burnt in the left hand with the letter 'I'
Nevertheless we grant unto her the said Mary McGuire
our firm peace and will not that she suffer any corporal
or other punishment therefor, but that she shall stand and
be in the same plight and condition to all intents and pur-
poses whatsoever as if the crime whereof she the said Mary
McGuire hath been convict had never been done or committed
Provided that she the said Mary McGuire shall within
twenty Days after the Delivery of these presents transport
or cause herself to be transported out of this State & never return
again - Given under the Seal of the State of Maryland this twenty second
day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred eighty seven
