with force and arms at the County aforesaid in and upon

the Peace of God and of the State then and there being
feloniously, wilfully and of his Malice aforethought
did make an Assault and that he the said Jacob
North a certain Car of the value of five shillings
which he the said Jacob North in both his hands
then and there had and held the said the said Thomas
in and upon the right side of the Head of him the
said Thomas just above the Temple of the Head of
