

13. In the said Thomas then and there feloniously, wilfully
and of his Malice aforethought did beat strike and bruise
giving to the said Thomas then and there with the Carap
in and upon the aforesaid right side of the head of him
the said Thomas just above the Temple of the head of
him the said Thomas divers mortal strokes, blows and
bruises of which said mortal strokes blows and bruises
the said Thomas from the said fifteenth Day of April
in the year aforesaid until the sixteenth Day of the
same Month of April in the year aforesaid at the
County aforesaid did languish and languishing did live
on which said sixteenth Day of April in the year aforesaid
at the County aforesaid of the said mortal strokes, blows
and bruises did die - Nevertheless we grant unto
him the said Jacob North our firm Peace and will
not that he suffer any corporal or other Punishment
therefor but that he shall stand and be in the same
plight and condition to all Intents and purposes
whatsoever as if the Crime or Offence aforesaid
had never been committed -
