To all our Baileys and good  
people to whom these presents shall  
come Greeting.

I know Ye that of our especial  
Grace we have pardoned unto John Manning late of Dorchester  
County Planter as an object of our Mercy the Suit of our  
Peace and whatsoever aspernation there is unto us for that he  
not having the fear of God before his Eyes, but being moved  
and seduced by the instigation of the Devil on the Eighteenth  
Day of October in the year of our Lord seventeen hundred  
and Eighty six with force and arms at the County aforesaid  
in and upon One Roger Murray in the Peace of God  
and the said State of Maryland then and there being  
feloniously and in the fury of his mind did make an  
assault and that the said John Manning with both  
his hands and feet the said Roger Murray to and against  
the Ground then and there feloniously and in the fury of  
his mind did cast and throw and the said Roger Murray  
so upon the ground lying, he the said John Manning with  
both the hands and feet aforesaid of him the said John  
Manning the said Roger Murray in and upon the  
head, stomach, back and sides of him the said Roger  
Murray then and there feloniously, and in the fury of his  
mind did strike, beat and kick giving to the said Roger  
Murray as well by casting and throwing of him the  
said Roger Murray to the ground aforesaid as also by  
striking, beating and kicking the said Roger Murray
