

for receiving and secreting stolen Goods, which said Indictments are now depending against him in the Generall Court of the western shore; and Whereas it is represented that he is a Dangerous Man, and that it would be greatly for the advantage and safety of the Inhabitants of Baltimore to grant a *Woli prosequi* on condition that he the said *Wanna han* leaves the State - I have therefore thought proper that all Proceedings at Law against the said James *Wanna han* for or concerning the said Offense or Offences do cease and determine, and that no further Prosecution be had or carried on against him for or concerning the same. Provided the said James *Wanna han* shall within forty Days from the delivery hereof transport or cause himself to be transported out of this State, and within six Months thereafter out of the United States to some one of the West India Islands or otherwise beyond the Seas and never return again, and Provided also that the said James *Wanna han* shall within twenty Days from the Date hereof execute a Bond to this State with good and sufficient Security to be approved by John Moale and Thomas Russell Esquires of Baltimore Town in the penalty of not less than five hundred pounds for his the said James *Wanna han*'s peaceable and honest behaviour towards the State and its Inhabitants during his continuance therein.
