shall come Greeting

Know ye that of our especial

Grace we have pardoned unto Cornelius Wetts late of Baltimore
County Yeoman as a proper object of our Mercy the Suit of
our Peace and whatsoever appertaineth unto us for that
he on the tenth Day of November in the year of our Lord one
thousand seven hundred and eighty six, with force and
arms at the County of Talbot in the night time of the
said Day the public Warehouse commonly called Emersons
Warehouse in the said County of Talbot then situate, felo-
niously did break and enter and one hoghead of Tobacco
of the value of twenty five pounds current Money of the
Goods and Chattels of Helen, Elizabeth - Agnes Sarah -
Mary - Mary and a Nation's Magwell then and there in
the said Warehouse being found then and there felonious-
ly did steal take and carry away contrary to the Act
of Assembly in that case made and provided and against
the Peace Government and Dignity of the State of Mary-
land - for that he the said Cornelius Wetts on the same
tenth Day of November in the year aforesaid with force
and arms at the County of Talbot in the night time of
the same Day the public Warehouse commonly called
Emersons Warehouse in the said County of Talbot then
situate feloniously did break and enter and one Hoghead
of Tobacco of the value of twenty five pounds current Money
