thousand seven hundred and eighty seven - & Nevertheless we
grant unto him the said Cornelius Wells our firm Peace and
Will not that he suffer any Corporal or other Punishment
therefor but that he shall stand and be in the same
Flight and Condition to all Intents and Purposes what-
soever as if the Crimes whereof he the said Cornelius
Wells hath been convicted, or either of them had never
been done or committed. Provided the said Cornelius
Wells shall within forty Days after the delivery of
these Presents transport or cause himself to be transport-
ed out of this State and never return back into it
again.

Given under the Seal of the
State of Maryland this thirtieth Day of May in
the Year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and
eighty seven. —
