

with force and arms at the County of Baltimore the Store
house of a certain Samuel Blanchard then there situate,
feloniously and Burglariously did break and enter, and four
pairs of calamanco shoes of the value of five Shillings
current money each pair, one piece of Black calamanco
of the value of thirty shillings current money, and one
piece of Black Sattinett of the value of thirty five Shillings
current money of Maryland of the goods and Chattels
of the said Samuel Blanchard, then there in the said Store
house, being found then and there feloniously and Burglariously
did steal, take and carry away contrary to the Act of
Assembly in that case made and provided, and against
the peace, Government and Dignity of the State of Maryland
whereof he the said John Shays hath been convict, before
the Worshipfull John Moate and others his Associates
Justices of Baltimore County Court held at the Court house
in Baltimore Town in and for the County aforesaid, the
Tuesday before the first Monday preceeding the first Tuesday
in February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven
hundred and eighty seven. Nevertheless we grant
unto him the said John Shays our firm peace and Will
not that he suffer any Corporal or other punishment therefor,
but that he shall stand and be in the same plight and
condition to all intents and purposes as if the Crime
whereof he the said John Shays hath been convict, had
never been done or committed. But we expressly Will
and enjoin, as the ^{and condition} terms of our pardon that the said John
Shays shall within Ten Days after the Delivery of these
presents depart this State and never afterwards return
