

whereof he the said Michael Fitzgerald hath been convicted before the worshipful Edward Burgess and other Justices of the Montgomery County Court aforesaid begun and hold at the Court house in and for the County aforesaid on the second ~~day~~ Tuesday of November being the thirteenth Day of the same Month Anno Domini seventeen hundred and eighty seven. Nevertheless we grant unto him the said Michael Fitzgerald our full Pardon and will not that he suffer any corporal or other Punishment therefor, but that he shall stand and be in the same Plight and Condition to all Intents and Purposes whatsoever as if the Crime whereof he the said Michael Fitzgerald hath been convicted had never been done or committed. But we do expressly will and require as the terms and Condition of our Pardon that the said Michael Fitzgerald shall within thirty Days after the Delivery of these Presents depart this State and never afterwards return back into it. Given under the Seal of the State of Maryland this Twenty third Day of January in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and eighty eight.
