Delivery held for Queen Anns County at Chester Mill
in the State and County aforesaid on the Thirty first Day
of December in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven
hundred and Eighty Seven **NEVERTHELESS** we grant
unto him the said William Turner our firm Peace and
Will not that he suffer any Corporal or other Punish-
ments therefor but that he shall stand and be in the
same Plight and Condition to all Intents and Purposes
 WHATSOEVER as if the Crime whereof he hath been convict
or either of them had never been done or committed
