

2 Coin called Spanish Milled pieces of Eight of the value of twenty
two Pounds ten Shillings Given Money of the Goods Chattels
and Monies of the said John Fogwell, in the Duelling house
aforesaid then and there violently and feloniously did steal
take and carry away against the peace Government and
Dignity of the State of Maryland whereof he the said George
Thomas hath been convicted before the worshipful honorable Sir
Arthur Emory Edward Dawson and John Fisher Judges of
a Special Court of Oyer and terminer and Goal Delivery
held for Queen Anne's County in the State aforesaid at Chester
Mill in the said County on the ^{thirty} first Day of December in the
year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty seven
Nevertheless we grant unto him the said George Thomas
our firm Peace and will not that he suffer any corporal
or other Punishment therefor but that he shall stand and
be in the same Plight and Condition to all Intents and
Purposes whatsoever as if the Crime whereof he the said
George Thomas hath been convicted or either of them had
never been done or committed Provided the said George
Thomas shall within thirty Days after the Delivery of these
Presents depart from this State and the United States within
thirty Days thereafter and that he never return back into this
State or either of the United States Given under the Seal
of the State of Maryland this first Day of March in the
Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and
Eighty eight
