preceeding the first Tuesday in February in the Year of our  
Lord One thousand seven hundred and Eighty eight  
Nevertheless we grant unto him the said John Webb our  
firm Peace and will not that he suffer any Corporal or  
other Punishment therefor but that he shall stand and lie  
in the same Plight and Condition to all Intents and  
Purposes whatsoever as if the Crime whereof the said  
John Webb hath been Convict had never been done or  
committed But we do expressly Will and enjoin as the  
terms and Condition of our Pardon that the said John  
Webb shall within Thirty Days from the Delivery hereof  
leave this State and shall within Thirty Days thereafter leave  
the United States and never return back into this or  
either of the United States GIVEN under the Seal of the  
State of Maryland this Seventeenth Day of <sup>March in the year of</sup> our Lord  
One thousand Seven hundred and Eighty Eight
