 14th Day of January last, a Bundle of papers and a Gun
 and the said Samuel Maubbs by his Petition having
 earnestly solicited the interposition of Government, and the
 said Peter Jennings having also solicited the same, and
 acknowledged to have received full reparation for the
 injury aforesaid. I have thought proper to order and direct
 that all Proceedings at Law for the said Offense, so far
 as he might be criminally affected, do cease and de-
 termine.
