Grace we have pardoned unto John Allen late of Baltimore
County Yeoman, as a proper object of our mercy the Suit
of our Peace and whatsoever appertaineth unto us for that
he on the twenty sixth Day of April in the year of our
Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty eight, between the
hours of ten and twelve in the night of the same day with
force and Arms at the County of Baltimore the Manser
house of a certain John Weaver then there situated, feloniously
and burglariously did break and enter and fifteen pieces
of coined Silver common called Spanish milled Dollars
of the value of and current in this State for seven shillings
and six pence each, two petty coats of the value of seven
shillings and six pence current Money, two Linsey petty coats
of the value of seven shillings and six pence, one
Cloth Cloak of the value of ten shillings, one pair
