

of Leather Breeches of the value of twenty five shillings, one pair of Cotton Stockings of the value of Three shillings and nine pence, one Coat of the value of Seven shillings and six pence, one Jacket of the value of two shillings and six pence, two Jackets of the value of five shillings current Money, two pair of Trousers of the value of two shillings and six pence and one Ladies short Gown of the value of ten shillings current Money of Maryland of the Goods and Chattels of the said John Weaver then there ~~detained~~ in the said Mansion house being found there and there feloniously and burglariously did steal take and carry away against the peace Government and Dignity of the State of Maryland - whereof he the said John Allen hath been convicted before the worshipful Samuel Chase and others his associates Justices of the Court of Oyer and Terminer and Goal delivery held at the Court house in Baltimore Town in and for the County aforesaid the fourth Tuesday in June in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty eight Nevertheless we grant unto him the said John Allen our firm Peace and Will not that he suffer any corporal or other punishment therefor but that he shall stand and be in the same plight and Condition to all Intents and purposes whatsoever as if the crime whereof he the said John Allen hath been convicted had never been done or committed - Provided that the said John Allen shall within thirty days from the delivery hereof transport or cause himself to be transported out of this State and never return back into it - Given under the Seal of the State of Maryland this third day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven
