To all our Bailiffs and good
 People to whom these Presents shall come

Whereas on the fifth Day of
 March fifteen hundred and eighty eight our Pardon was
 granted to Samuel Wilson who had been tried at, and convicted
 in the County Court of Baltimore hold on the Tuesday
 before the Monday preceding the first Tuesday in February
 in the year of our Lord one Thousand seven hundred and
 eighty eight for feloniously breaking and entering the house
 of a certain Abraham Enzor, and stealing thereout and carrying
 away many Articles of Wearing apparel, of the Goods,
 and Chattels of the said Abraham Enzor, which said Pardon
 was conditioned that he the said Samuel Wilson should
 within thirty Days from the delivery of the same leave
 this State, and should also within thirty days thereafter
 leave the United States and never return back into this
 or either of the United States - And whereas the said
 Samuel Wilson at a Court of Oyer and Terminer and
 Goal delivery hold at the Court house in Baltimore town
 in and for the County aforesaid the fourth Tuesday in
 June in the year aforesaid hath been indicted tried and
 convicted of returning contrary to the terms and conditions
 of his said Pardon - and thereupon sentenced by the said
 Court to be carried to the place from whence he came
 and from thence to the place of execution, and there be
 hanged by the Neck until he be dead - We have therefore
 of our especial Grace pardoned unto the said Samuel
