

and never afterwards return back into it. And whereas the said Thomas Watson at a Court of Oyer and Terminer and Goal delivery held at the Court house in Baltimore Town in and for the County aforesaid the fourth Tuesday in June in the year seventeen hundred and eighty eight hath been indicted, tried and found guilty of returning contrary to the terms and conditions of his said pardon, and thereupon sentenced by the said Court to be carried to the place from whence he came and from thence to the place of execution and there be hanged by the neck until he be dead. We have therefore pardoned unto the said Thomas Watson not that he suffer any corporal or other punishment therefor, but that he shall stand and be in the same plight and condition to all intents and purposes whatsoever as if the crime aforesaid had not been committed; but we do hereby declare that nothing herein contained shall affect or be construed to affect the execution of any sentence or adjudication of the Court aforesaid passed on the said Thomas Watson for any other offence than what is herein particularly specified —
