

Yeoman as a proper object of our mercy, the suit of our peace, and  
 whatsoever appertaineth unto us, for that he on the thurlieth day  
 of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred  
 and eighty between the hours of ten and twelve in the night  
 of the same Day, with force and arms at the County of Baltimore  
 and within the Jurisdiction of the County Court of the said County  
 the Mansion house of a certain Thomas Comtable then there  
 situate feloniously and burglariously did break and enter, and  
 one silver pint Mug of the value of three pounds current  
 Money of Maryland, and six silver Tea spoons of the value  
 of ten pounds current money of Maryland of the Goods and  
 Chattels of the said Thomas Comtable then there in the said  
 Mansion house being found then and there feloniously and  
 burglariously did steal take and carry away against the peace  
 Government and dignity of the State, whereof he the said  
 Timothy Murphy hath been convict before the worshipful  
 Andrew Buchanan and others the then Justices of the County  
 Court of the same County hold at the Court house in Baltimore  
 town in and for the County of Baltimore the Tuesday before the  
 Monday preceeding the first Tuesday in February in the year  
 of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty one. Nevertheless  
 we grant unto him the said Timothy Murphy our firm peace  
 and will not that he suffer any corporal or other punishment  
 therefor but that he shall stand and be in the same plight and  
 condition to all intents and purposes whatsoever as if the crime  
 whereof he the said Timothy Murphy hath been convict had  
 never been done or committed - Provided that he the said  
 Timothy Murphy shall within twenty Days after the delivery  
 hereof transport or cause himself to be transported out of the
