Know ye that of our especial

Grace we have pardoned unto Negro Cato state of Kent County slave of Turbutt Wright Esquire, as a proper object of our mercy the suit of our peace and whatsoever appertaineth unto us for that he on the fifteenth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty eight at the County aforesaid feloniously did break and enter the store house of a certain James Armstrong then there situate, and one piece of Irish linen of the value of three pounds, two shillings and six pence current money of Maryland, two pair of Cotton stockings of the value of thirteen shillings two pair of shoes of the value of fifteen shillings and one pair of Womens gloves of the value of three shillings current money of Maryland of the Goods and Chattels of the said James Armstrong then and there in the said store house found then and there feloniously stole took and carried away against the form of the Act of Assembly
