Whereas James Dunn alias George King

late of Frederick County yeoman, was at a County Court begun and held at Frederick Town in and for the County aforesaid on the third Tuesday and eighteenth day of November seventeen hundred and eighty eight, tried and found guilty of having on the tenth day of November in the year of our Lord seventeen hundred and eighty eight broke and entered the Mansion house of a certain Edward Mobby of said County and stole thereout one cloth coat and one knife of the value of six shillings and six pence current Money of Maryland of the Goods and Chattels of the said Edward Mobby, and thereupon the said James Dunn alias George King was by the Justice of the said Court sentenced to work and labour on the public roads in Baltimore<sup>sh</sup> County for the term of four years to commence from the 21<sup>st</sup> Day of November 1788 I have thought it proper to pardon the said James Dunn alias George King for the offense aforesaid and do hereby order and direct that he be forthwith discharged from the service to which he hath been sentenced - Given under the Seal of the State of Maryland in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and
