To all our Bailiffs and
 good people to whom these presents
 shall come Greeting

Whereas John Russell late of
 Baltimore County, was at a Court of Oyer and terminer and
 goal delivery hold for said County the twenty fourth day of
 June Seventeen hundred and eighty eight, indicted, tried and
 found guilty of two several felonies viz^t Hog stealing, and
 Cow stealing - and thereupon adjudged to work on the public
 roads of Baltimore County or in making repairing and
 cleaning the Streets or Basin of Baltimore town, one
 year for the first and two years for the second Offense -
 And three of the Justices of the said Court having recom-
 mended him for a pardon - I have thought it proper
 to pardon the said John Russell for the Offences afore-
 said, and do hereby order and direct that he be forthwith
 discharged from the service to which he hath been sentenced

 land this twenty third Day of September in the year
 of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty eight

Whereas Charles King late of Balti-
 more County Yeoman, hath been indicted in the Criminal
