

not that he suffer any corporal or other punishment there-
 -for but that he shall stand and be in the same plight
 and condition to all intents and purposes whatsoever as
 if the crime whereof he the said Negro Anthony alias King
 hath been convict had never been done or committed.
 But we do expressly will and enjoin as the terms and
 condition of our pardon that his said Master Thomas
 Pennington, shall on or before the first day of June
 next, transport or cause to be transported to some one
 of the West India Islands or otherwise beyond the
 Seas, the said Negro Anthony alias King, never
 to return back into this or either of the United States

Whereas James Doyle late
 of Washington County, at a County Court held at Elizabeth-
 town in and for the County aforesaid on the fourth Tues-
 -day of March seventeen hundred and eighty nine, was
 tried and convicted of Stealing six bags and one Curry Comb
 and thereupon for the offence aforesaid adjudged by the Jus-
 -tices of the said Court to work and labour for the term of
 two years from the twenty sixth day of March 1789
