Greeting

It is eas on the twenty second day of November last a presentment found against Beno Sucker & others herein mentioned was tried in the Court of Oyer & Terminer and goal delivery for Baltimore County for receiving of Negroes, Adams and Will late of the said County Slaves of John Mcall Esqur twelve Bacon Hams, of the value of twenty pounds of Tobacco each, the property of Richard Linson, knowing the same to be stolen and thereupon the said Beno Sucker was found guilty and sentenced by the said Court to work and labour on the public Roads of Baltimore County for one year or in Making upaining or cleaning the streets or Mason of Baltimore town And the said Beno Sucker having been recommended by two of the Justices of the said court and several inhabitants of Baltimore County to the Clemency of Government I have thought it proper to pardon the said Beno Sucker for the offence aforesaid and do hereby order and direct that he be forthwith discharged from the service to which he hath been adjudged Given under the Seal of the State of Maryland the Nineteenth Day of February in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety
