thought it proper to Pardon the said John Sheppard
for the offence aforesaid and do hereby order and direct
that he be forthwith discharged from the service to
which he hath been adjudged Given under the Seal
of the State of Maryland this twenty ninth Day
of April in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven
hundred and Ninety —
