to pardon the said Arthur Batory for the Offence aforesaid,
and do hereby order and direct that he be forthwith discharged
from the Service to which he hath been adjudged - Given
under the Seal of the State of Maryland this twentieth day
of May in the Year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred
and Ninety -

Annapolis May 26th 1790

Whereas Nicholas Soaster late of Baltimore
County Yeoman Standt indicted in the General Court
for the Murder of Robert Williams, a Mariner on
board the Brigantine Aurora committed the tenth
Day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand
six hundred and eighty eight near Point Comfort in
Chesapeake Bay without the Body of the State of Maryland
and within the Body of the State of Virginia I have
thought proper to order and direct that all Proceedings
at Law for the said Offence do cease and determine, and
that no further Prosecution be had or carried on or against
the said Nicholas Soaster for or Concerning the same -
