County Spinster was presented by the Jurors for the County of
Baltimore County aforesaid for Stealing and carrying away
on the tenth day of May last one quarter of Pea of the value
of four Shillings Current Money of Maryland of the goods
and Chattels of William Tidy and that on the sixteenth
Day of August instant by a trial of a Jury of the facts above
contained before the Justices of Baltimore County Court of
Oyer and Terminer and Goal delivery the said Ann
Hamet was found guilty thereof and was adjudged by the said
Justices to serve and labour in the work house agreeably to
Act of Assembly for three Months - And whereas a
Number of respectable inhabitants of Baltimore among whom
are the Jury; having recommended her to the Clemency of
Government I have thought it proper to pardon the said
Ann Hamet by the Name aforesaid; and do hereby order
