good People to whom these Presents shall come Greeting

Whereas Samuel Wilson of Baltimore County was at a Criminal Court for said County in June term one thousand seven hundred and eighty eight indicted and convicted of a Burglary committed in the Mansion house of Granbury Barton on the Night of the first of May preceding and was sentenced to work and labour on the public Roads of the said County for the term of seven Years, And whereas several respectable Inhabitants of the said County have solicited a Pardon for the said Samuel Wilson. I have thought it proper to Pardon the said Samuel Wilson for the offence aforesaid, on Condition that he leaves this State within ten days after the delivery of these Presents and never returns back into it, And I do hereby order and direct that he be discharged from the Service to which he hath been sentenced on his engaging to comply with the Condition aforesaid. Given under the Seal of the State of Maryland this twenty fourth Day of August in the
