

Money, One Caser hat of the Value of five Shillings Current
 Money and Twenty one Check handkerchiefs of the Value of five
 Shillings Current money each handkerchief the goods and
 Chattels of the said Frederick Whizel then and there in the said
 Store House being found then and there feloniously stole took
 and Carried away contrary to the Act of Assembly in that Case
 Made and provided and against the Peace Government and
 Dignity of the State of Maryland. Whereas the said
 Adam hath been convicted before the worshipful Edward Bur-
 gess, and others, his Associates, Justices of the County Court
 of the same County held, at the Court house in and for the
 County aforesaid on the second Tuesday of August being the
 tenth Day of the same Month Anno Domini seven hundred
 and Ninety. Nevertheless we grant unto him the said
 Adam our firm Peace and will not that he suffer any
 Corporal or other Punishment therefore but that he shall
 stand and be in the same plight and Condition to all
 intents and purposes whatsoever as if the Crime aforesaid
 had never been committed. Given under the Seal of the
 State of Maryland this Twenty second Day of October
 in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and
 Ninety —
