Whereas Elmor Rawley late of
Baltimore County Spinstar, was indicted for stealing and
carrying away on the first day of November last, One Slip
of the value of one Shilling, four neck hankie-sups of
the value of four shillings, one Cotton Hankiechief of the
value of one Shilling, one check Hankiechief of the value
of one Shilling, one Shirt and one half of a Shirt of the
value of nine shillings, and one Muslin Apron of the
value of four shillings, of the Goods and chattles of
one Jacob Ballaberg and that on the seventeenth
day of the same month and year aforesaid by the trial
of a Jury, of the facts contained in the Indictment above
mentioned against the said Elmor Rawley before the
Justices of Baltimore County Court of Oyer and Terminer
and Goal delivery, she was found guilty thereof, and
was adjudged by the said Justices to serve and labour
