

in the Indictment abovementioned against the said Andrew Welsh before the Justices of Baltimore County Court of Oyer and Terminer and Goal delivery, he was found guilty thereof, and was adjudged by the said Justices to work and labour on the public roads of Baltimore County or in making repairing and cleaning the Streets or Basin of Baltimore Town for the space of one year from the said thirteenth day of August seventeen hundred and ninety - And whereas the said Andrew Welsh having been recommended to Government for a pardon I have thought it proper to pardon the said Andrew Welsh for the offence aforesaid, and do hereby order and direct that he be forthwith discharged from the service to which he hath been adjudged.
