Whereas William Lindall
late of Baltimore County Yeoman was indicted for
Stealing and carrying away on the fifth day of March
last Eleven Hens each of the value of one Shilling
Current Money of Maryland of the Goods and Chattels
of Anthony Stock - And that at March term instant
on a trial by a Jury of the facts contained in the
said Indictment, the aforesaid William Lindall
was found guilty, and was adjudged by the Justices of
Baltimore County Court of Oyer and Terminer and Goal
delivery to work and labour on the public Roads of
Baltimore County, or in making, repairing and cleansing
the Streets or Basin of Baltimore town for Eighteen
Months from the fifteenth day of March instant

And Whereas several respectable inhabitants of
Baltimore town having recommended him for a Pardon
I have thought it proper to pardon the said William
Lindall for the Offence aforesaid and do hereby order
and direct that he be forthwith discharged from
the Service to which he hath been adjudged - Provided
that he the said William Lindall pays all the costs
accruing on the prosecution against him, and provided also
that he shall within thirly days from the delivery hereof
leave this State and never return back into it again - Given under
