Whereas an Indictment hath been  
found in the General Court for the western Shore at  
this present term against James Barry late of Baltimore  
County Merchant, and William Buchanan late of the  
same County Merchant, for feloniously wilfully, and  
of their Malice aforethought being present aiding abetting  
assisting and maintaining a certain Thomas Hadfield  
in the felony and murder of David Sterrett of the  
same County Merchant - And Whereas several  
respectable inhabitants of Baltimore Town have earnest-  
ly solicited the interposition of Government in their  
favor I have thought proper to order and direct that all  
Proceedings at Law for the said Offence do cease and  
determine, and that no further prosecution be had or  
carried on against them or either of them for or con-  
cerning the same -
