

the western shore of the State aforesaid in May last, indicted, tried and found guilty of stealing taking and carrying away one Bay mare of the value of twenty pounds Current Money of Maryland of the Goods and Chattels of John Lape whereupon the said Andrew Miller was by the Court aforesaid adjudged to serve and labour for three years on the public roads of Baltimore County or in making repairing or cleaning the Streets or Bason of Baltimore Town - I have thought it proper to pardon the said Andrew Miller for the offence aforesaid and do hereby order and direct that he be discharged on condition that he pays all the legal costs accrued in the Prosecution, and shall also within thirty days after the delivery hereof leave this State and never thereafter return back into it.

Given under the Seal of the State of Maryland this fifth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety one.
