The State of Maryland.

To all our Bailiffs
and good people to whom these presents
Geo. Hall, shall come Greeting

Know ye that of our especial Grace
we have pardoned unto Edward Morris of Baltimore
County as an Object of our Mercy the Suit of our peace
and Waffower appertaining unto us, for that he on the
second day of November in the year of our Lord one
thousand Seven Hundred and ninety one at the County
of Baltimore with force and arms, twenty Cars of
Indian Corn of the value of six pence current Money of
Maryland of the Goods and Chattels of John Robert
Rutledge then there found, then and there feloniously did
steal take and carry away against the peace Government
and Dignity of the State of Maryland. Nevertheless
we grant unto him the said Edward Morris our firm
Peace and will not that he suffer any corporal or other
punishment therefor, but that he shall stand and be
in the same plight and Condition to all intents and
purposes whatsoever as if the Crime or Offence aforesaid
had never been committed.

Given under the Seal of the State
of Maryland this twenty first day of November in the
year of our Lord one thousand Seven Hundred and
ninety one
