

during his stay therein and this grant of Noli prosequi is also on the express condition that the said Elijah Gaither do within twenty days from the time he shall be discharged from confinement in Goal depart this State and that he do not at any time thereafter return into the same. And if the said Elijah Gaither do not fully and strictly comply with all, and every of the Terms and conditions aforesaid then this grant of Noli prosequi is declared to be null and void, so that no benefit or advantage shall arise to the said Elijah Gaither from the same or any part thereof.
